Lili Pan, Founder, Managing Director, L GEES Limited

Lili Pan has been working on LEED projects since 2008, and provided LEED consultant services for many landmark projects in East Asia. She has practiced 'life cycle energy performance quality assurance' in those projects through energy modeling, building commissioning/retro commissioning and measurement & verification. As an author of several papers and publications, including 'Commissioning requirement shall be

incorporated into China Green Building Rating system', published at IC-GEEB, Beijing, Lili is actively engaged in green building research. She is also a PhD candidate at Cardiff University with research topic related to green building performance verification.

Ms. Lili Pan is the first and so far the only Emerging Professional awarded by USGBC in Greater China region. In 2013, she received USGBC 'LEED in Motion' interview as the sole representative of LEED International Round Table Members which is constituted by LEED APs from 30 countries.
