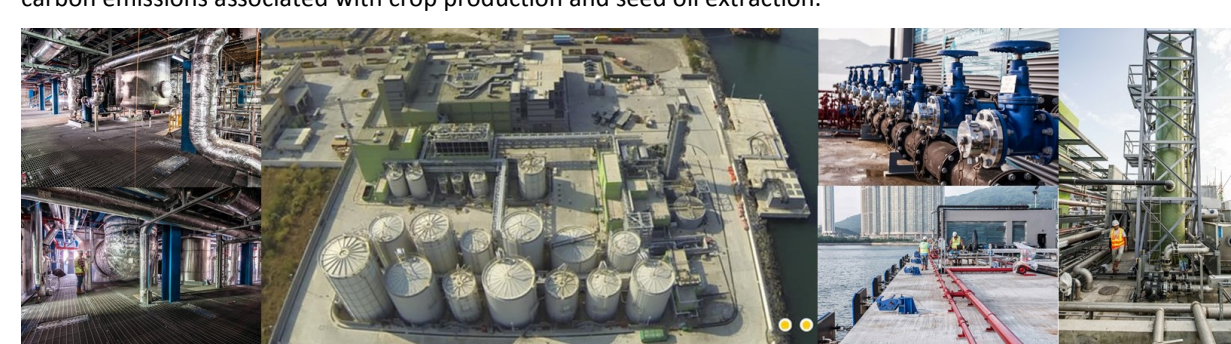

Biodiesel is a clean, low-carbon transport fuel that can be used as a substitute for fossil diesel, or blended with fossil diesel in diesel engines without modification.

ASB Biodiesel operates a biodiesel factory in Hong Kong with the capacity to produce 100,000 tons of low-carbon transport fuel per year. Since biodiesel is produced from waste, it does not lead to land use changes. It also significantly reduces greenhouse gas emissions in the manufacturing process by avoiding the upstream carbon emissions associated with crop production and seed oil extraction.
